# THE MINORITY ENGINEERING PROGRAM

## DESCRIPTION OF THE MEP PROGRAMS

**ENGINEER-FOR-A-DAY** - provides high school students with the opportunity to experience (first hand) campus life and learn more about the diversified curricula of The College of Engineering. Participants will spend an evening and a day as “guest” of minority undergraduate engineering hosts. During the visit, they will sit in on selected engineering classes, tour engineering departments, meet eminent OSU engineering faculty, and explore the campus, including sports and recreational facilities.

**PREFACE** - is a six-week summer residential program which provides intensive instruction and seminars, to prepare students planning to pursue engineering studies for college work. Rigorous college preparatory classes in physics, chemistry, mathematics, engineering graphics and English are taught by OSU faculty and staff. Seminars to improve collaborative learning strategies, test taking abilities, study habits, organizational and time management skills are offered to enhance academic success. Participants will live and dine in OSU residence halls and enjoy the university's recreational facilities. Following the academic program, every effort will be made to place participants in six-week engineering related jobs.

**MEP SCHOLARSHIPS** - The College of Engineering offers a number of scholarships specifically to attract students of African, Hispanic and American Indian descent. These scholarship are funded entirely from foundations, companies, and alumni who support the concept of diversity for excellence. Further, the support for MEP is only a part of the support these constituents provide to the College.

All applicants for MEP scholarship must have attained high levels of scholastic achievement in a college preparatory curriculum which emphasizes mathematics and the physical science. Awards are based on merit. The program also includes special counseling, academic advising, tutoring and continuous monitoring of progress and performance of recipients throughout their academic careers at OSU.

## GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE APPLICATION PROCESS

### **WHO SHOULD APPLY?**

Students who will contribute to diversity in student enrollment, who are currently enrolled in the twelfth grade, who have demonstrated academic achievement in mathematics and science, and who are interested in pursuing engineering studies are encouraged to apply.

### **HOW TO APPLY?**

Complete the application on the reverse side. Each applicant must arrange to have all information returned in one envelope which should contain: a) application; b) high school transcript; c) applicant statement; d) letter of recommendation from the applicant's current mathematics/science teacher written on school stationery.

### **DEADLINE FOR APPLYING:**

All applications should be postmarked no later than the date stamped on the application. Applicants for PREFACE are encouraged to apply early to facilitate job placement. All applicants will be notified by mail of their acceptance or rejection.
